In Years 7 and 8 all students study English, Maths, Science, French, Art, Humanities (History, Geography, RE), Technology, Performing Arts (Dance, Drama, Music), ICT and PE.

In years 10 and 11, all students follow a broad range of GCSE courses.

Support

Support for **SEND** students is provided in class. In addition, 1:1 and small group sessions are provided for students who are identified as needing intervention.

We also make provision for Gifted & Talented students, including our exciting STEM club.

The progress of all students is monitored closely. Academic support is provided by the Progress and Guidance team for students who fall behind or need extra time to catch up missed work.



Time 4 Success!

All students are part of **Time for Success (T4S)** every day at Greenfield.

Every student belongs to a vertical Tutor Group in one of our nine Houses. During T4S sessions they work in this group, taking part in reading for pleasure as well as becoming involved in Student Voice, charity work and a range of other exciting opportunities to extend their learning. At the heart of the process is Enquiry 4 Success: an innovative learning approach to some of life's big questions.

Tutors work closely with their group, mentoring students and monitoring academic progress, behaviour, attendance and engagement on a daily basis.

Within the broad and balanced curriculum all students receive the full range of opportunities available in our specialist subjects of **visual arts, performing arts and the sciences**.
