Role:

Specific Duties:

Teaching and Learning

- In discussion with the Head Teacher, plan and prepare engaging lessons based on agreed schemes of work
- Teach engaging and effective lessons that motivate, inspire and improve pupil attainment
- Use regular assessments to monitor progress, set targets and determine appropriate intervention
- Maintain regular assessments to monitor progress, set targets and determine appropriate intervention
- Maintain regular and productive communication with parents, to report on progress, sanctions, rewards and to relay other relevant information
- Maintain accurate pupil data that can be used to make teaching more effective
- In conjunction with the Head Teacher, identify the intervention needs of pupils and appropriate strategies to improve attainment
